	MAG 135 on carbon steel materials, plate and pipe butt welds, plate and pipe fillet welds and corner fillet welds in all positions to a high visual and x-ray standard
	2. FCAW-G (136) on carbon steel materials (same as above)
	3. TIG 141 on carbon steel materials, pipe butts in all positions to a high visual and x-ray standard
	4. TIG 141 on 2mm & 3mm 300 series stainless steel materials, closed butt, corner and fillet welds in all positions to a high visual standard
	5. TIG 141 on 3mm 5000/6000 series aluminium materials, closed butt, corner and fillet welds in all positions to a high visual standard
	6. MMA 111 on carbon steel materials, plate and pipe butt welds, plate and pipe fillet welds and corner fillet welds in all positions using E7016 & E7018 electrodes to a high visual and x-ray standard
	7. In-depth understanding, appreciation and application of visual/NDT inspection standards such as ISO 5817 and ISO 10042
	8. Knowledge, experience and application of processes developments such as 135 Pulse, 135 STT, 141 Pulse, etc.
